



HOW I LEARNED TO FLY

Adventurous and funny Sofija (12) is forced to spend her vacation with her overbearing grandmother Maria (67), on an island in Croatia. It's not the ideal summer experience she had hoped for, but with the help of her warmhearted old aunt Luce (65) and her charming cousin, Sofija overcomes her initial boredom. She makes new friends and together they explore everything the summer on the island has to offer: sparkling sun, fun in the water, lots of ice cream and her first kiss. But her carefree time comes to an abrupt end, when beloved Luce has to be taken to hospital, leaving Sofija with a part of her family she didn't even know existed. Nevertheless, in the wake of tragedy, the family finally overcomes old traumas and when Sofia returns home, she realizes that revealing painful secrets is challenging but very liberating.

An entertaining family film that takes you on a charming, yet emotional summer adventure by the sea.

SOMEWHERE OVER THE CHEMTRAILS

by Adam Koloman Rybanský Comedy, Czech Republic, 2022, 85 min

Clumsy Standa and recently widower Bronya are volunteer firefighters in a small village where they enjoy a quiet and peaceful life. Things begin to change when a van crashes into a crowd of people during the Easter Fair. Before anyone notices, the driver runs away from the car crash. People believe it is a terrorist attack and the festive mood is replaced by an atmosphere of fear, hatred, and misinformation. Bronya, who is convinced of terrorism, is trying to do something to improve the situation. The sense of danger pumps new blood into his veins, and the fire brigade becomes a militia.

Director Adam Koloman Rybanský's confidently told and rhythmically compelling debut examines the mechanisms of racism and exclusion in the microcosm of a village. At the same time, he takes a loving and humorous look at human weakness, revealing a deeply humanist worldview.

HEAVENS ABOVE

by Srdjan Dragojević

Black Comedy, Serbia/Germany/North Macedonia/Croatia/Slovenia/Montenegro/Bosnia and Herzegovina, 2021, 122 min

Darkly humorous, Heavens Above tells three stories set in 1993, 2001 and 2018. Opening in a post-Communist refugee camp at the edge of Serbian slum, an unasked-for miracle is granted to a salt-of-the-Earth ex-Communist soldier, much to the distress of his mystically inclined wife. The miracles continue as the second story unfolds, this time centered on a holy fool and priest whose prayers are answered with dark consequence. The third story reunites the family from the first, now in very changed circumstances, while the holy fool has grown into an artist whose paintings themselves are miraculous.

LIBORIO
